Raffle Prize Question

- A1 appears to be injured and play is stopped by one of the officials.
- A. The athletic trainer and/or coach comes on the floor to check on A1.
 - B. A1, however, is OK and seems ready to play within a few seconds.
 - C. The athletic trainer comes on the floor to assist A1. Once A1 has been removed from the court, the official notifies the head coach from Team A that a replacement is required. The coach acknowledges the notification, and the official then instructs the timer to begin the replacement interval because a substitute is not made available immediately. Team A's head coach then requests a time-out to keep A1 in the game.
 - D. How long is the replacement interval?
 - E. When is the horn sounded during a replacement interval?
 - F. What happens if the substitute has not reported before the end of the replacement interval?

Raffle Prize Answer

- A. A1 must be removed as bench personnel (athletic trainer and/or coach) came onto the court. (The coach may also call a time-out to keep the player in the game provided the replacement interval for the substitution has not begun.) (10-4-2; 3.3.6a)
- B. A1 may remain in the game if the coach (or other bench personnel) does not come onto the court and A1 is ready to play immediately. (3.3.6b)
- C. The time-out request must be made when the official informs the coach that a replacement is required. Once the 20-second interval has begun and A1's replacement is pending, a time-out shall not be granted. Once A1 is replaced by a substitute, Team A may request and be granted a time-out, if desired. (2-12-5 Note, 3-3-6 Note 2, 5-8-3b; 3.3.6c)
- D. 20-seconds (2-12-5)
- E. A warning signal should be sounded 15 seconds before the expiration of the 20 seconds (maximum) permitted for replacing a disqualified or injured player, or for a player directed to leave the game. (2-12-5)
- F. A technical foul is charged directly to the coach. (10-5-2; 10.5.2b) Two free-throws are awarded to Team B, and Team B is awarded the ball for a division-line throw-in.
